

## GEWURZTRAMINER 2011 «VENDANGES TARDIVES»

Gewurztraminer 2011 «Vendanges Tardives» is produced from Lieux-dits Muehlforst and Trottacker in Hunawihr & Ribeauvillé when the climatic conditions are superb. The average yield for this wine was 25 hl/ha from old vines (40 years old).

« Vendanges Tardives » wines or “V.T.s” mean Late Harvests and are rather exceptional wines which follow a very strict regulation, one of the most severe in all French AOC.

Pierre Trimbach has been the President of the Committee for VTs and SGNs in Alsace since 2000.

2011 was a fantastic vintage for “V.T.s”, thanks to the superb climatic condition Alsace enjoyed in September and October.

This wine has been produced mostly from «**passerillage**».

The potential at harvest was 17,4° when the law requires 15.3° (16° since 2012).

It's a full-bodied, succulent Gewurztraminer “Vendanges Tardives” which should please all lovers of sweet wines which displays elegance thanks to its fresh natural acidity.

Pair with some duck foie gras, some powerful cheeses and/or some fruity desserts, or enjoy it just for itself as a meditation wine!
